

ORDINANCE BILL NO. 10 FOR 1936

ORDINANCE NO. 480

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 81 OF ORDINANCE NO. 276, PASSED BY THE COUNCIL ON THE 27th DAY OF JUNE, 1921, RELATING TO THE FIRE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, OREGON, AS AMENDED.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section 81 of Ordinance No. 276 passed by the Council on the 27th day of June, 1921, as amended, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 81. That the fire limits of the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, shall comprise the territory embraced within the following described boundaries, to-wit: Beginning at the Northwest corner of the intersection of Main and Oak Streets and running thence East to the Northwest corner of the intersection of Oak and Park Streets; thence North to the Southwest corner of the intersection of Park and Vine Streets; thence West to the Southeast corner of the intersection of Second and Vine Streets; thence South to the Southeast corner of the intersection of Second and Ash Streets; thence West to the Southeast corner of the intersection of Third and Ash Streets; thence South to the Southeast corner of the intersection of Third and Grant Streets; thence East to the Southeast corner of the intersection of Grant and Second Streets; thence South to the Northeast corner of Oak and Second Streets; thence East to the beginning.

PROVIDED That the City Council of said City may, by resolution, grant applications for the erection of frame buildings in that portion of the fire limits herein defined lying West of Second Street in said City.

PROVIDED FURTHER That property within said boundaries used and occupied or which has heretofore been used and occupied exclusively for residence purposes and which is detached from



any other building may be altered or repaired in like manner as if it were outside the fire limits; and

PROVIDED FURTHER That new, detached residences may be erected within said fire limits, except that between Ash Street and Maple Street no residence may be erected upon any lot abutting upon Main Street so that the same shall be closer than 100 feet to the line of said Main Street, and

PROVIDED FURTHER That any building now within said above described fire boundaries may be repaired with new materials if, in the judgment of the committee on Streets and Public Property, and also in the judgment of the Chief of the Fire Department, it is safe to make such repairs, and such repairs do not increase the fire hazard, and the said building is, in other respects, in a safe and secure condition, so that such building when repaired will be safe for all purposes for which it may be used and not be a menace to the public.


A detached dwelling or residence as described and used in this Section is a dwelling which is at least 25 feet from any other building except a private garage or other out-building, and no part of which is used for business or commercial purposes.

Section 2. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.


Section 3. This Ordinance being necessary for the immediate protection of the public peace, health, safety and morals, the same shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
