

ORDINANCE BILL NO. 13 FOR 1936

ORDINANCE NO. _____

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR MINIMIZING INTERFERENCE WITH RADIO RECEPTION, PROVIDING A PENALTY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful to operate any generator of electromagnetic waves or disturbances, detectible by radio receiving apparatus, and of such magnitude as to interfere with the proper functioning of the radio receiving sets in the City of Lebanon.

Section 2. Any person who violates any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine not exceeding \$100.00 or by imprisonment in the City jail for a period not exceeding twenty days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 3. Inasmuch as this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City of Lebanon, the same shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
