

ORDINANCE NO. 485

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE OPERATION AND MOVEMENT OF BICYCLES ON THE STREETS, ALLEYS AND PUBLIC PLACES OF LEBANON, OREGON, THE DEPOSITING THEREOF ON SIDEWALKS IN SAID CITY, MAKING REQUIREMENTS AS TO THE LIGHTING EQUIPMENT FOR BICYCLES, REGULATING THE OPERATORS AND RIDERS ON BICYCLES, AND PROVIDING FOR PUNISHMENT FOR THE VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE, INCLUDING THE IMPOUNDING OF BICYCLES.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. No person shall ride any bicycle upon any street, alley or public place in the City of Lebanon during the period from a half hour after sunset to a half hour before sunrise, or at any time when fog or other atmospheric conditions render the operation of said bicycle dangerous to traffic or to the use of the streets, or at any other time when there is not sufficient light to render clearly discernible any person on a street at a distance of two hundred feet, without having a lighted lamp on the front of said bicycle visible under normal atmospheric conditions from a distance of at least three hundred feet in front of such bicycle, and also a reflex mirror or lamp on the rear of said bicycle exhibiting a red light visible under like conditions from a distance of at least two hundred feet to the rear of such bicycle.

Section 2. No person shall operate or ride on any bicycle upon any street, alley or public place in the City of Lebanon, Oregon, with two or more persons on the same bicycle.

Section 3. No person, while riding on a bicycle on any street, alley or public place in the City of Lebanon, Oregon, shall hold on to any other vehicle.

Section 4. No person shall ride any bicycle on any sidewalk in the City of Lebanon, Oregon, at a place where there is a hard surface pavement on the street adjacent to the place where said bicycle is so ridden; provided, however, that the provisions of this section shall not apply to any person regularly engaged in the delivery of newspapers and mail.

Section 5. Pedestrians shall at all times have the right-of-way on sidewalks over any person riding on the sidewalk while engaged in the regular delivery of newspapers and mail, and every such person so riding on a sidewalk in the City of Lebanon, Oregon, while engaged in the regular delivery of newspapers and mail, shall exercise extreme caution so as to avoid impact with every pedestrian, and in the event any person so engaged in riding a bicycle on any sidewalk in the City of Lebanon, Oregon, shall strike any pedestrian on said sidewalk it shall be presumed that the operator of said bicycle was guilty of negligence in violation of the foregoing provision of this ordinance.

Section 6. Every person riding a bicycle on any street, alley or public place in the City of Lebanon, Oregon, shall keep said bicycle on the extreme right of the traffic lane, and it shall be unlawful for more than two operators of bicycles to travel abreast on any street, alley or public place in the City of Lebanon, Oregon; provided, however, that when two operators of bicycles travelling abreast on any sidewalk shall approach or overtake any pedestrian they shall yield one-half of the sidewalk.

Section 7. Every person riding a bicycle on any street, alley or public place in the City of Lebanon, Oregon, shall be subject to all provisions of the laws of the State of Oregon and the ordinances of the City of Lebanon, Oregon, applicable to the driver of a vehicle, except the provisions thereof which by their very nature can have no application.

Section 8. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to run or engage, or to cause to run or be engaged, in any bicycle race on any street, alley or public place within the limits of the City of Lebanon, Oregon, except under permit from and under the supervision of the Chief of Police of said City.

Section 9. No person shall leave any bicycle lying on any sidewalk or street in the City of Lebanon, Oregon, any place where the same will interfere with or hinder traffic, and when any person shall leave a bicycle the same shall be set in an upright position against the curb along the street or upon a bicycle stand, adjacent to the curb.


Section 10. Any person who shall violate any provision of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof before the City Recorder of Lebanon, Oregon, be punished by a fine of not more than \$25.00 or by imprisonment in the City Jail not more than ten days, or by both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the City Recorder, and in addition thereto the City Recorder of the City of Lebanon, Oregon, may, either in lieu of or in addition to such fine and imprisonment, prohibit the operation upon the streets, alleys and public places of the City of Lebanon, Oregon, of the bicycle used in such violation of any provision of this ordinance for a period of not to exceed 30 days, in which event the bicycle so used in such violation shall be impounded with the Chief of Police of said City and retained by him for the period that the operation thereof is prohibited as aforesaid.

Section 11. That any ordinance of the City of Lebanon in conflict with any of the provisions hereof is hereby repealed.

Section 12. This Ordinance being necessary for the immediate protection of the public peace, health, safety and morals, the same shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
