

ORDINANCE BILL NO. 7 FOR 1937

ORDINANCE NO. 491

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 2 OF ORDINANCE NO. 472 ENTITLED, "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE TO LICENSE PIN BALL GAMES AND OTHER GAMES OF LIKE CHARACTER INVOLVING AN ELEMENT OF SKILL, REPEALING ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY", AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. That Section 2 of Ordinance No. 472 of the City of Lebanon passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor on the 21st day of January, 1936, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 2. The owner or proprietor of any place of business in the City of Lebanon shall pay to said City a license fee of \$ 5.00 per month, or part of month if maintained for less than a month, which license fee shall be paid in advance on the first business day of each and every calendar month for every such machine maintained in such place of business.

Section 2. This ordinance being necessary for the immediate protection of the public peace, health, safety and morals, the same shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.


