

ORDINANCE NO. 492

ORDINANCE REQUIRING TRAFFIC TO STOP AT THE INTERSECTION OF ACADEMY AND SECOND STREETS; PROVIDING FOR ERECTING "STOP" SIGNS TO THE ENTRANCE TO SAID INTERSECTION AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE.

The people of the City of Lebanon do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That all traffic proceeding East on Second Street in Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, and approaching the intersection of said street with Academy Street shall stop before proceeding into the said intersection.

Section 2. That all traffic proceeding North on Second Street and approaching the intersection of said street with Academy Street shall stop if a left turn is to be made to continue on said Second Street; provided, however, that nothing herein shall prevent traffic proceeding North on Second Street and approaching the intersection of said street with Academy Street from turning East into Academy Street without stopping.

Section 3. That there shall be erected and maintained a standard "Stop" sign at the Western approach to the intersection of Second and Academy Streets and there shall be erected and maintained at the Southern approach to the intersection of Second and Academy Streets a standard "Stop" sign to which shall be added the words "Right Turn Permitted."

Section 4. That it shall be unlawful for any vehicle to make a reverse turn in the intersection of Second and Academy Streets.

Section 5. That any person violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof before the City Recorder, be fined not to exceed \$10.00 which fine shall be collected in the manner of other fines.
