

ORDINANCE BILL NO. ⁵~~4~~ FOR 1938

ORDINANCE NO. 495

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A "NO PARKING ZONE" ON MAIN STREET IN FRONT OF THE GEM THEATER, REGULATING THE USE THEREOF, PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the space on the West side of Main Street, adjacent to the curb and extending North and South 20 feet, immediately in front of the entrance to the Gem Theater, is hereby designated as a "No Parking Zone."

Section 2. That the boundaries of said Zone shall be plainly marked by strips of paint on the surface of the street and on the curb of the sidewalk and appropriate portable signs may be placed in plain view on the sidewalk adjacent to the curb along said Zone, or on the street in said Zone, during theater hours, to inform the public that parking is prohibited in said Zone during a theater performance.


Section 3. That it shall be unlawful for any motor or other vehicle to park in said Zone while such signs are displayed in accordance with Section 2 hereof.

Section 4. That any person, firm or corporation, its agents or employees, violating any provision of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof before the City Recorder of Lebanon, Oregon, be punished by a fine of not more than \$100.00, or by imprisonment in the city jail not more than ten (10) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the City Recorder.

Section 5. This Ordinance being necessary for the immediate protection of the public peace, health, safety, and morals, an emergency is hereby declared, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.


