A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO.494, ENTITLED:

"A Bill for an Ordinance to ascertain and determine the cost of a certain lateral sewer laid in the above described Sewer Improvement District; to ascertain, assess, determine, and declare the proportionate share of the cost of such improvement to be borne by the property owners to be assessed against each lot and tract of land benefitted thereby; and to direct to the Recorder to enter a statement of such assessment in the Docket of City Liens as provided by the Charter of said City."

WHEREAS, On the 22nd day of June, 1938, the owners of all property abutting upon the above described Sewer Improvement District filed with the Council their petition for the laying of said lateral sewer and asked that the cost thereof be borne by the owners of the property abutting upon and especially benefitted thereby, and waiving the requirements of advertising or calling for bids and notice of intention to make said improvement or any further notice of any kind, and

WHEREAS, The Council did, on the 22nd day of June, 1938, order the City Engineer to make plans, specifications, and estimates for the proposed lateral sewer, and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 494 was passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor on the 16th day of August, 1938, levying an assessment for the cost of said sewer, but upon reconsideration the Common Council desires to charge Sixty and No/100 Dollars (\$60.00) of the cost of said sewer improvement to the City of Lebanon and deduct said sum from the cost of the improvement to be borne by the property benefitted thereby, and

WHEREAS, The Council has found additional real property to be especially benefitted by said sewer improvement,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO
ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Sections 1 and 2 of Ordinance No. 494
be amended to read as follows:

"Section 1. That the cost of the construction
of said lateral sewer in said Sewer Improvement Dis-
trict which is to be borne by the property especially
benefitted thereby is the sum of Two Hundred Eighty
and No/100 Dollars (\$280.00).

Section 2. That the proportionate share of the
cost of said improvement to be borne by the real
property abutting thereon and to be assessed upon
the lots and tracts of land benefitted thereby is
hereby ascertained and declared to be the amounts
set immediately after the separate description of
each of said lots or tracts of land, and each of
said lots and tracts of land is determined and de-
clared to be benefitted by said improvement in the
sum equal to or greater than the amount assessed as
follows, to-wit:


Maude I. Burtenshaw:

Number of feet: 406 Assessment: \$ 140.00"


