

ORDINANCE BILL NO. 12 FOR 1938

ORDINANCE NO. 501

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE PARKING OF TRAILERS WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, PROVIDING FOR PUNISHMENT FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, OREGON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That it shall be unlawful for any person, firm, or corporation to park any trailer on any street within the fire limits of the City of Lebanon as prescribed by Ordinance No. 480 of said City, unless said trailer is connected with the vehicle which propels it, and the same shall not then be parked for a period of more than one (1) hour.


Section 2. That it shall be unlawful to park any detached trailer on any street within the limits of the City of Lebanon and outside the fire limits, as established by Ordinance No. 480 of said City, between sunset and sunrise without lights burning on the front and rear thereof which shall be visible for a distance of not less than three hundred (300) feet.

Section 3. That any person, firm, or corporation, upon conviction of violation of this Ordinance in the Recorder's Court, shall be punished by a fine of not more than One Hundred and No/100 Dollars (\$100.00), or by imprisonment in the City Jail not exceeding ten (10) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment, in the discretion of the City Recorder.

Section 4. This Ordinance being necessary for the immediate protection of the public peace, health, safety, and morals, the same shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.


