## ORDINANCE BILL NO. 13 FOR 1938 ORDINANCE NO. 502

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF SIDEWALKS IN THE CITY OF LEBANON, OREGON, SPECIFYING THE KINDS OF MATERIAL TO BE USED IN THE CONSTRUCTION THEREOF, REPEALING ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, OREGON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That except as herein provided all sidewalks built and constructed or replaced hereafter shall be constructed of cement, sand, and gravel in the proportions of 1, 2, and 4 mix, shall be made by the one-run process, and of the dimensions and in the location, with reference to the property line along which said sidewalks run, as heretofore provided by Ordinances of the City of Lebanon.

Section 2. That whenever any sidewalk along the streets of the City of Lebanon shall be replaced or repaired, or a new sidewalk constructed, either by voluntary action of the property owner or upon Order of the Common Council of said City, as by Ordinances heretofore provided, and the owner of the property upon which said sidewalk or proposed sidewalk abutts shall desire to construct the same of other materials than provided in Section 1 hereof, he shall make an application in writing to the Common Council, describing the premises upon which said sidewalk or proposed sidewalk abutts, specifying the type of sidewalk he proposes to build, and may therein request an Order of said Common Council to build the same out of such materials as provided by the Ordinances of said City; that if, in the judgment of said Council, it shall seem proper to rebuild said sidewalk or build a new one out of materials other than cement, it may, by Resolution, grant said property owner the right to build the same.

Section 3. That nothing contained in the Ordinance shall prevent the repairing of any sidewalk heretofore existing within said City with similar materials to those with which it was originally constructed, if, in the judgment of the Street Committee of said Council, such repairs can be made to place said sidewalk in a safe and proper condition.

Section 4. That all Ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 5. That financial aid from agencies of the Federal Government being available for the repair and replacement of sidewalks of said City, which aid may be withdrawn at any time if prompt advantage thereof is not taken, and this Ordinance being necessary for the peace, health, and safety of persons and property of said City, an emergency is hereby declared and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
