

ORDINANCE BILL NO. 8 FOR 1939

ORDINANCE NO. 511

WHEREAS, A large majority of the owners of the premises abutting upon Park Street between Dodge and Wheeler Streets have petitioned the Council requesting the widening of said street in said block by reducing the curb line from eight (8) feet to three (3) feet from the sidewalk on each side of the said street; and


WHEREAS, The Council believes that a re-establishment of the curb lines in said block is advisable and beneficial to said property and to the City of Lebanon in general,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the curb lines on each side of Park Street between Dodge and Wheeler Streets be and the same are hereby re-established and set at nine (9) feet from the property line on each side of said street. ~~between Dodge and Wheeler Streets.~~

Section 2. This Ordinance being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of the people of said City, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.

Passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor this 19th day of December, 1939.
