## ORDINANCE BILL NO. FOR 1940

### ORDINANCE NO. 514

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING THE POLLING PLACES, NAMING JUDGES AND CLERKS, PROVIDING FOR THEIR OATH, AND PROVID: ING FOR GIVING NOTICE OF A SPECIAL ELECTION TO BE HELD IN THE CITY OF LEBANON, COUNTY OF LINN, STATE OF OREGON, ON FRIDAY, THE 17th DAY OF MAY, 1940, AND DIRECTING THE RECORDER AND MARSHAL OF SAID CITY TO PROCURE THE NECESSARY SUPPLIES AND FREPARE THE POLLING PLACES FOR SAID ELECTION.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, OREGON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the polling places for the special election to be held in the City of Lebanon, County of Linn, State of Oregon, on Friday, the 17th day of May, 1940, pursuant to Resolution No. 2 for 1940, passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor on the 5th day of March, 1940, shall be as follows, to-wit:

First Ward, In the sales room of the Kirkpatrick Motor Company, Second and Sherman Streets in said City.

Second Ward, In the high school gymnasium on the campus of the high school of Linn County School District No. 16, in said City.

Third Ward, On the first floor of the I.O.O.F. Lodge Building at the corner of Main and Ash Streets in said City.

Section 2. The judges and clerks for said election shall be as follows:

Section 3. That previous to entering upon the discharge of their duty, said judges and clerks shall take and subscribe an oath in substantially the following form, to-wit:

"I DO SOLEMNLY SWEAR (OR AFFIRM) THAT I WILL PERFORM THE DUTIES OF A JUDGE (OR CLERK AS THE CASE MAY BE) OF ELECTION ACCORDING TO LAW AND THE BEST OF MY ABILITY; THAT I WILL STUDIOUSLY ENDEAVOR TO PREVENT FRAUD, DECEIT AND ABUSE IN CONDUCTING THE SAME."

said oath to be administered to the said judges and clerks by an officer authorized by law to administer oaths, and in the absence of any such officer, one of the persons chosen to act as judge is hereby empowered to administer the oath to the judges and clerks of said election, and the person administering the oath shall cause an entry thereof to be made and subscribed by him and prefixed to the poll books.

Section 4. That if any judge or clerk of said special election, as above named, shall be absent at the opening of the polls, the electors present may fill such vacancies.

Section 5. The City Recorder shall cause a notice of said special election to be given by publication thereof in a newspaper of general circulation, published within the City of Lebanon, once a week for two successive and consecutive weeks within thirty days next preceding such election, which said notice shall be substantially in the following form, to-wit:

## SPECIAL ELECTION NOTICE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN That pursuant to Resolution No. 2 for 1940, passed by the Common Council and approved by the Mayor of the City of Lebanon, County of Linn, State of Oregon, on the 5th day of March, 1940, a special election will be held in said City on Friday, the 17th day of May, 1940, for the purpose of submitting to the legal voters of said City of Lebanon, for their approval or rejection, the proposition of amending Section 34, of Article I, Chapter III of the Charter of said city to provide for the election of the Superintendent of Streets, Marshal, Night Police, City Engineer, Health Officer, City Attorney and all other minor officers of said City by a vote of a majority of all members of the Council.

That said special election will be held, commencing at 8:00 A.M. and continuing until 8:00 P.M. of said day.

That the polling places for said election in the several wards of said City will be as follows:

First Ward, In the sales room of the Kirkpatrick Motor Company, Second and Sherman Streets in said City.

Second Ward, In the high school gymnasium on the campus of the high school of Linn County.School District No. 16, in said City.

Third Ward, On the first floor of the I.O.O.F. Lodge Building at the corner of Main and Ash Streets in said City.

Section 6. The City Recorder shall cause to be printed and shall supply a sufficient number of ballots, copies thereof, poll books, ink, pencils, stationery and other necessary and proper supplies for said election and the City Marshal is hereby directed to install voting booths and deliver the ballots, ballot boxes and other supplies to the said judges and clerks of election in the said voting place in due time for their use by the voters, judges, clerks and other persons interested in said special election.

Section 7. This ordinance, being necessary for the immediate protection of the public peace, health, safety and morals, the same shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.

Passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor this 16th day of April, 1940.
