## ORDINANCE BILL NO. 9 FOR 1941 ORDINANCE NO. 528

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE LEVYING ASSESSMENTS FOR THE COST OF A STREET IMPROVEMENT BY THE LAYING OF A STRIP OF PAVEMENT 6 FEET WIDE ON EACH SIDE OF THE PAVEMENT ON PARK STREET FROM THE NORTH LINE OF GRANT STREET TO THE NORTH LINE OF ASH STREET, AND BY THE REMOVAL OF PARKING, AGAINST THE PROPERTY ESPECIALLY BENEFITTED THEREBY; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

whereas, More than 50 per cent of the property owners abutting upon Park Street, between the North line of Grant Street and the North line of Ash Street, in Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, have filed with the City Recorder of the said City of Lebanon their) Petition asking for the improvement of the above described portion of Park Street by the laying of a strip of pavement six feet wide on each side of the pavement thereon, and by the necessary removal of parking, upon the proposition that the property owners shall pay the cost of the materials, and the cost of the labor shall be paid by a grant of Federal funds to the City of Lebanon; and

WHEREAS, The Common Council of the City of Lebanon, Oregon, did, by Resolution No. 20 for 1940, passed by said Council and approved by the Mayor of said City on the 3rd day of September, 1940, order the City Engineer of said City to prepare and file plans, specifications and estimates of said improvement and the total probable cost thereof; and

whereas, The said City Engineer did thereafter prepare and file plans, specifications and estimates of said improvement and the total probable cost thereof, which said plans, specifications and estimates were approved and ratified and affirmed by Resolution No. 21 for 1940, passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor on the 17th day of September, 1940; and

WHEREAS, Notice of said proposed improvement was thereafter duly given in the manner provided by Charter, by means of publication thereof, and no remonstrance was thereafter filed against said improvement within the time provided by Charter, and after hearing thereon said Council found said improvement necessary and proper and ordered the same to be done; and

WHEREAS, Said work and improvement has been completed and approved, and the cost thereof has been determined and is the sum of Seven Hundred Sixty Two and 26/100 Dollars (\$762.25).

NOW, THEREFORE, THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the cost of said improvement to be borne by the property abutting the abovedescribed portion of Park Street and especially benefitted by said improvement, is the sum of Seven Hundred Sixty Two and 26/100 Dollars (\$762.25).

That the said City of Lebanon having seriously depleted its funds, and this Ordinance therefore being required for the peace, health and safety of said City, an emergency is hereby declared and said Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
