ORDINANCE BILL NO. 26 FOR 1941

MADE IN 1941 ORDINANCE NO. 545

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR FIRE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF LEBANON; FOR CONSTRUCTION AND EQUIPMENT OF BUILDINGS; PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF; REPEALING CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The following shall be ^{and} are hereby declared to be the fire limits of and for the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, to-wit:

Beginning at the Southwest corner of the intersection of Park Street and Vine Street in said City; running thence South along the West side of said Park Street and along the West side of said Park Street extended to the North line of the Mountain States Power Company canal; thence Southwesterly along the North line of said canal to the North line of the Southern Pacific Railway right-of-way; thence West on the North line of said right-of-way to the West line of Main Street; thence on the West line of Main Street to the Northwest corner of the intersection of Main Street and A Street; thence West on the North line of A Street to the Northeast corner of the intersection of A Street and Second Street; thence North on the East line of Second Street to the Northeast corner of the intersection of Second Street and Oak Street; thence West on the North line of Oak Street to the Northeast corner of the intersection of Oak Street and Third Street; thence North on the East line of Third Street to the Southeast corner of the intersection of Third Street and Vine Street; thence East on the South line of Vine Street to the place of beginning; all in the said City of Lebanon.

Section 2. That part of "Code of Suggested Ordinances for Small Municipalities" recommended by the National Board of Fire Underwriters, 85 John Street, New York, published as Revised Reprint, 1938, commencing with the words "Section 2. Permits and Inspections." on page 3 of said publication, and concluding with the word "Ordinance." in line 7 on page 24 of the publication of said Code, a copy of which said publication is attached hereto and marked "Exhibit A", is hereby specifically referred to and incorporated herein as a part of this Ordinance, including those words filling in the blank spaces in said Code as printed. 
Appendix A of said Code which commences with the word "dwellings" in the fourth line of page 25 of said publication and concludes with the word "shingles" on the 21st line of said page 25, shall be a part of Section 14 of said Code.

Section 3. The various notes and footnotes appearing within the abovementioned portion of said Code shall not be deemed or construed as any portion of this Ordinance.

Section 4. All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of their inconsistency herewith, but to no further extent.


Section 5. Inasmuch as some person contemplates the immediate construction of a building not in accordance herewith, which would create a great and continuing danger to persons and property within said City of Lebanon, this Ordinance is necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of said City and an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor of said City.
