ORDINANCE NO. 555

ORDINANCE CREATING EMERGENCY PARKING SPACE EAST OF THE ALLEY ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF SHERMAN STREET BETWEEN MAIN AND SECOND STREETS IN THE CITY OF LEBANON, LINN COUNTY, OREGON, DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND PROVIDING PENALTY FOR VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the first parking space East of the Alley on the South side of Sherman Street, between Main and Second Streets in Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, shall be and is hereby designated and reserved for the exclusive use of emergency vehicles, and said space shall be plainly marked as such; that no vehicle other than emergency vehicles shall occupy said space, and there shall be no limit of time for the parking of emergency vehicles therein.

SECTION 2. That any person, firm, or corporation violating Section 1 of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof in the Recorder's Court, be fined not more than Fifty Dollars.

SECTION 3. Because of congested parking conditions in the City of Lebanon and the necessity for some designated parking space to be reserved for emergency vehicles, it is deemed for the best interest of the peace, health, and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon that this Ordinance should be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.

THEREFORE, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
