ORDINANCE NO. 559

AN ORDINANCE SETTING THE SALARIES OF CERTAIN OFFICERS OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:


SECTION 1. That the monthly salaries of certain City officers shall be the amounts set after their names as follows:

| City Treasurer  | 20.00 per month    |
| City Attorney   | 35.00 per month    |
| Superintendent of Streets                                 | 125.00 per month   |
| City Marshall   | 135.00 per month   |
| Night Police  | 120.00 per month   |
| Special and Extra Police,<br>employed on a monthly basis, | 100.00 per month   |
| Fireman employed on a monthly<br>basis                    | 120.00 per Month   |

SECTION 2. In that no official action has heretofore been taken setting the salaries of the officers hereinabove named, in accordance with provisions made in the City budget heretofore adopted, and such salaries should be payable before the time this ordinance could otherwise take effect, and this ordinance being necessary for the peace, health, and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.

## ORDINANCE NO. 559

AN ORDINANCE SETTING THE SALARIES OF CERTAIN OFFICERS OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

The people of the city of Lebanon do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the monthly salaries of certain city officers shall be the amounts set after their names as follows:

| Firemen employed on a monthly<br>basis                  | 120.00 per month   |

Section 2. In that Inasmuch as no official action has heretofore been taken setting the salaries of the officers hereinabove named, in accordance with provisions made in the city budget heretofore adopted, and such salaries should be payable before the time this ordinance could otherwise take effect, and this ordinance being necessary for the peace, health, and safety of the people of the city of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage by the council and approval by the mayor.
