AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCE NO. 552, ADOPTED BY THE COUNCIL AND APPROVED BY THE MAYOR ON JULY 15, 1941, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section 1 of Ordinance 552, passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor on the 15th day of July, 1941, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 1. That the first diagonal parking space East of Main Street and on the North side of Sherman Street shall be and the same is hereby set aside and designated as a Taxi Stand.

Section 2. It being proper that the parking of taxis in the City of Lebanon be regulated for the health, peace, and safety of the people of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.

Passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor this 6th day of October, 1942.
