

ORDINANCE BILL NO. 3 FOR 1943

ORDINANCE NO. 581

Code 11-1

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE LICENSING OF GARBAGE COLLECTORS,
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:


SECTION 1. That it shall be unlawful for any person, firm, or corporation to collect garbage within the City of Lebanon without obtaining from the City Recorder a license therefor, except from canneries and food processing plants, the collection of garbage and debris from which shall not apply hereto.

SECTION 2. That the license for collection of garbage within the limits of the City of Lebanon shall be \$ 40.00 per calendar year or part thereof, and said license shall not be transferable.

SECTION 3. That any person, firm, or corporation violating the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof before the Recorder's Court of the City of Lebanon, Oregon, be punished by a fine of not more than Fifty and No/100 Dollars (\$50.00) nor less than Five Dollars (\$5.00), or by imprisonment in the City Jail for not more than twenty (20) days nor less than two (2) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

SECTION 4. That it being necessary to provide a license to properly regulate the collection of garbage in the City of Lebanon, this Ordinance is necessary for the peace, health, and safety of the citizens thereof, and an emergency is, therefore, hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
