

ORDINANCE NO. 582 ✓*Code no. 5-13*

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE THE MANNER AND TIME OF SPRINKLING LAWNS, YARDS, AND GARDENS IN THE CITY OF LEBANON; AND PROVIDING FOR THE PUNISHMENT OF ANY VIOLATION HEREOF.

The people of the city of Lebanon do ordain as follows:

Section 1. The time and hours for sprinkling or irrigating lawns, yards, and gardens with water from the Lebanon water system shall be from 5 a.m. to 8 a.m. and from 5 p.m. to 9 p.m.

Section 2. Only one nozzle or sprinkler or hose shall be used by one family for one lot; provided, that where a family pays for more than one lot for irrigation purposes it may use a hose or sprinkler, the opening of which shall not exceed five-sixteenths of an inch in diameter, and shall not irrigate or sprinkle except with such a hose or sprinkler.

Section 3. It shall be unlawful for any person to use any water from the Lebanon water system for sprinkling or irrigation at any time or at any hour except as provided in Section 1 of this ordinance, and no sprinkler shall be placed so as to throw water on or across any sidewalk or any street.

Section 4. When a fire alarm is sounded for a fire in the city of Lebanon, it shall be the duty of any person who has a faucet or hose or sprinkler running with water from the Lebanon water system to immediately shut the same off and to keep the same securely shut off so long as the fire may continue or the use of the water is needed for fire fighting.

Section 5. Every person on leaving the vicinity of his premise shall shut off all faucets on the premise and keep the same shut off during his absence, unless some person of mature age is left at home, who shall shut the faucets off in case of a fire alarm.

Section 6. Any person violating this ordinance shall be punished by a fine not exceeding \$20 or by confinement in the city jail not exceeding ten days for each offense, and each day of a violation of this ordinance shall be deemed a separate violation and shall be punishable accordingly.
