AN ORDINANCE REGULATING ELECTRIC WIRING.

The people of the city of Lebanon do ordain as follows:

Section 1. The national electrical code as approved by the American Standards Association, together with all amendments to it now or hereafter adopted, is made a part of this ordinance.

Section 2. No person, firm, or association shall install, alter, or repair electric wiring in or on a structure without first obtaining from the city electrical inspector a permit to do so.

Section 3. No electric wiring, after being installed, altered, or repaired, shall be used until the city electrical inspector has issued a certificate of inspection approving it. Whenever the installation, alteration, or repair of electric wiring has been completed, the person, firm, or association owning or in charge of the wiring may request the inspector to inspect it and issue his certificate of inspection approving it. Within 48 hours after the request the inspector shall inspect the wiring, and if he finds that it complies with this ordinance, he shall issue his certificate of inspection approving it. The inspector shall not issue any certificate of inspection approving electric wiring which fails to comply with this ordinance.

Section 4. The city electrical inspector shall be appointed by the council. If the inspector is unable because of illness or absence from the city to fulfill his duties, then the chief of the fire department shall perform the duties of city electrical inspector.

Section 5. The fee for inspection of electric wiring shall be \$1 for the first hour and 75 cents for each additional hour required for inspecting the wiring. The minimum fee shall be \$1.

Section 6. The city electrical inspector may inspect any electric wiring at any time, and if he finds that it does not comply with the requirements of this ordinance, it shall be removed or repaired to comply with this ordinance within a reasonable time after he gives notice to the person, firm, or association owning or in charge of it that it does not comply with the requirements of this ordinance. No fee shall be charged for such inspection.

Section 7. Any person, firm, or association who violates this ordinance shall be subject to a fine of not less than \$10 and not more than \$50 or to imprisonment in the city jail not less than five days and not more than twenty-five days.
