

ORDINANCE BILL NO. 7 FOR 1943

ORDINANCE NO. 5820.

AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PORTION OF VINE STREET IN THE CITY OF LEBANON, LINN COUNTY, OREGON, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS Lebanon Lumber Company, a corporation, and the State of Oregon through and by the World War Veterans State Aid Commission, have petitioned the Common Council for an Ordinance vacating Vine Street from the intersection of Fifth Street East to the East line of Smith's First Addition to the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, a distance of 165 feet; and

WHEREAS all the Petitioners are the owners of all the abutting property on that portion of said street proposed to be vacated and are the only persons affected thereby, no notice is necessary to be given to any other person; and

WHEREAS said street is now a dead end street and that portion thereof asked to be vacated is not used by the public and the public will not be inconvenienced by the vacation thereof,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That by reason of the fact that all of the abutting property owners have joined in the request for the vacation of said portion of said street, no notice of vacation thereof is required.

SECTION 2. That Vine Street from the intersection of Fifth Street East to the East line of Smith's First Addition to the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, be and the same is hereby vacated.

SECTION 3. That the portion of said street hereby vacated being for the benefit and use of the Petitioners, of


which the Lebanon Lumber Company operates a large business and furnishes a large pay roll to the people of the City of Lebanon and vicinity, and will permit it to make better use of its abutting property, this Ordinance is for the peace, health, and safety of the people of Lebanon and an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.

Passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor this 2nd day of February, 1943.
