ORDINANCE BILL NO. 13 FOR 1943 ORDINANCE NO. 595 Juacture IX Jax Levies

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING A TAX OF FIVE MILLS FOR A SINKING FUND FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A SEWAGE DISPOSAL PLANT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO DRDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That a tax of five mills on the dollar on all taxable property in the City of Lebanon, in addition to the taxes now authorized by charter, is hereby levied for the fiscal year 1943-44 and thereafter, for the purpose of the sinking fund heretofore established, to be used for the construction of a sewage disposal plant for said City.

SECTION 2. That the Oregon State Sanitary Board having ordered the City of Lebanon to cease construction of any new sewer lines in the City of Lebanon until provision shall be made for the construction of a sewage disposal plant, this ordinance is, therefore, necessary for the protection of the peace, health, and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, and an emergency is hereby declared, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.

Passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor this 1st day of June, 1943.
