AN ORDINANCE SETTING SALARIES OF CERTAIN OF THE OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF LEBANON FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1943-44, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the salaries of certain of the officers and employees of the City of Lebanon for the fiscal year July, 1, 1943, to June 30, 1944, shall be and are hereby set as follows:

SECTION 2. That the officers and certain employees of the City of Lebanon above mentioned being entitled to receive their salaries for July 1943 without delay and this ordinance being necessary for the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
