ORDINANCE NO. 601

ACTIVE - 6-12

AN ORDINANCE APPOINTING THE SUPERINTENDENT OF STREETS AS PLUMBING INSPECTOR, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the Marshal is hereby relieved of the duties of the office of Plumbing Inspector, and the duties of said office are hereby transferred to the Superintendent of Streets, who shall hereafter be the Plumbing Inspector of the City and shall perform the duties thereof as provided by the Charter and ordinances.

SECTION 2. That all ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. That since sewer maintenance is a duty of the Superintendent of Streets, the duties of Plumbing Inspector can best be performed by him, and this ordinance being for the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.

Passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor this 5th day of October, 1943.
