ORDINANCE BILL NO. 22 FOR 1943

ORDINANCE NO. 604

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 519, PASSED BY THE COUNCIL AND APPROVED BY THE MAYOR ON THE 3rd DAY OF DECEMBER, 1940, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 519, passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor on the 3rd day of December, 1940, be and the same is hereby amended as follows: that there shall be added to said Ordinance a section as follows:

"Section 34 (a). It shall be unlawful for any minor to purchase, receive, accept, use, consume or possess any-intoxicating liquor."

Section 2. This ordinance being necessary for the peace, health, and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby decalred to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Countil and approval by the Mayor.

Passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor this 6th day of December, 1943.
