AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCE NO. 88, PASSED APRIL 20, 1909, AS AMENDED.

The people of the City of Lebanon do Ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. That Section 1 of Ordinance No. 88, passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor on the 20th day of April, 1909, and amended by Ordinance No. 134, passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor May 23, 1913, and amended by Ordinance No. 144, passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor November 18, 1913, be and the same is hereby amended to read and provide as follows:

"SECTION 1. All electric light poles hereafter set or placed in any street in the City of Lebanon, and all telephone poles, street car poles, and all other poles for wire set or placed in any street in the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, shall be so set and placed that the center of such pole shall be 9 feet out in the street from the property line of the land or lot adjacent to such pole, except on Milton Street where poles shall be so set that the outside thereof shall be 6 inches in from the curb line toward the property line; and all wires for any one service shall be uniform in height on the same side of the street; provided that at railroad crossings or street car crossings on any such street the wires and poles shall be at such height as may be necessary

and convenient for the traffic on such lines."

Passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor this 4th day of January, 1944.
