AN ORDINANCE INCREASING THE SALARIES OF CERTAIN OFFICERS OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

The people of the City of Lebanon do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the monthly salaries of certain City officers as set by Ordinance No. 596, passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor on January 20, 1942 respectively, are hereby increased six per cent (6%) effective the month of February, 1944.

Section 2. It being necessary to promptly pay the salaries of the officers of the City, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.

Passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor this 7th day of March, 1944.
