AN ORDINANCE SETTING SALARIES OF CERTAIN OF THE OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF LEBANON FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1944-1945, AND DECLARING AN EMERGANCY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the salaries of certain of the officers and employees of the City of Lebanon for the fiscal year July, 1, 1944, to June 30, 1945, shall be and are hereby set as follows:
