A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE CONVEYANCE OF CERTAIN REAL PROPERTY FOR A STREET

WHEREAS, the United States of America Federal Public Housing Administration has tendered to the City of Lebanon, Oregon, a Deed conveying to said City for street purposes the following described real property:

Beginning at a point at the intersection of the North line of Rose Street with the West line of 6th Street extended in the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon and running thence N.  $0^{\circ}23-1/2'$  W. along the extension of the West line of 6th Street 711.81 feet to a 2" iron bar; thence N.  $89^{\circ}44'$  E. 60 feet; thence S.  $0^{\circ}23-1/2'$  E. 711.81 feet; thence S.  $89^{\circ}44'$  W. 60 feet to the true point of beginning, containing .982 of an acre more or less.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE PEOPLE OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the conveyance of said real property to the City of Lebanon for street purposes be and the same is hereby accepted.
2. That the street conveyed by the description in said Deed shall bear the name of 6th Street.
3. Said street being necessary for ingress and egress to real property upon which the building of dwellings is anticipated to relieve the present housing shortage, this Ordinance is for the peace, health, safety, and general welfare of the people of the City of Lebanon, and an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.

PASSED by the Council and approved by the Mayor this 21st day of May, 1946.
