AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 626

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That Ordinance No. 626 be amended by adding Section 9A which shall provide as follows:

9A. All residences and other structures hereafter erected or placed in the residential zone shall be located no closer to the property line on the street bounding the premises than adjoining residences and structures, but in no case closer to said property line than fifteen feet.

SECTION 2. There being no regulation of the distance from the street property line at which structures in the residential zone shall be located, this Ordinance is for the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, and an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.

Passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor this 18th day of June, 1946.
