AN ORDINANCE SETTING SALARIES AND COMPENSATION FOR CITY OFFICERS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1946-47

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the salaries of officers for the fiscal year 1946-47 which shall be payable in monthly installments, except City Health Officer whose salary shall be paid quarterly shall be the sums set opposite the names of the respective offices as follows:

City Recorder	\$2,400.00
City Treasurer	420.00
City Attorney	900.00
City Health Officer	40.00
City Marshal	2,643.12
Night Police	2,340.00
Superintendent of Streets	2,700.00

SECTION 2. This Ordinance being necessary for the peace, health and safety of the citizens of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
