AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION NINE OF
ORDINANCE NO. 626

SECTION 1. Section Nine of Ordinance No. 626,
passed by the council and approved by the mayor on the
_____ day of _____ shall be and the same is
hereby amended to provide as follows:

In a Residential Zone no building shall be used and no building shall be erected or structurally altered except for residential purposes; provided that a private garage may be built and used in conjunction with each residential dwelling. For the purpose of this ordinance, schools, churches and apartment houses and other multiple dwellings except auto courts and similar establishments and the use of dwellings for such professions, pursuits and occupations as the practice of medicine, surgery, dentistry, selling insurance, real estate, the operation of beauty shops, photograph galleries and like businesses when they shall not cause an increase in the fire hazard or in the fire insurance rates of said dwelling or surrounding property, or use such machinery or devices or chemicals which shall create disturbing noises or odors, shall be deemed to be residential uses.
