ORDINANCE NO. 643

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 585 PASSED BY THE COUNCIL AND APPROVED BY THE MAYOR FEBRUARY 5, 1943.

The people of the City of Lebanon do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 585, passed by the council and approved by the mayor, the 5th day of February, 1943, be, and the same is hereby amended, by adding to Section 8 the following items:

Skee-ball games Taxi cabs \$7.50 per quarter \$12.50 per quarter for each parking space reserved.

Section 2. In that skee-ball cames and taxi cabs are in operation in the City of Lebanon without licenses or regulation, this ordinance is deemed necessary for the peace, health, and safety of the citizens of said City and shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council and approval by the mayor.
