ORDINANCE BILL NUMBER 9 FOR 1947
ORDINANCE NUMBER 646

AN ORDINANCE CALLING A SPECIAL ELECTION AUGUST 5, 1947
THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS
FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That there shall be submitted to the voters of the City of Lebanon for their approval or rejection at an election to be held in the said city on the fifth day of August, 1947, the following proposition:

That there shall be levied against all taxable property within the corporate limits of the City of Lebenon, Oregon, a special tax of five (5) mills, for the fiscal year 1948-49, to and including the fiscal year 1952-53, which shall be outside the six (6) per cent limitation as provided by Article XI, Section 11, of the Constitution of Oregon, for the purpose of providing funds for the construction of a municipal swimming pool and facilities in connection therewith.

Section 2. That the ballot title for the ballot shall be as follows:

That there shall be levied against all taxable property within the corporate limits of the City of Lebanon, Oregon, a special tax of five (5) mills, for the fiscal year 1948-49, to and including the fiscal year 1952-53, which shall be outside the six (6) per cent limitation as provided by Article XI, Section 11, of the constitution of Oregon, for the purpose of providing funds for the construction of a municipal swimming pool and facilities in connection therewith.

Section 3. That the City Recorder is hereby authorised and instructed to publish notice of said election in the manner provided by law.

Section 4. That the polling places for said election shall be as follows:

WARDS I & II WARDS III & IV WARDS V & VI First Presbyterian Church basement; Lebanon High School gymnasium; Girl Scout House on Queen Anne School grounds.

Section 6. That the polling places for said election shall be open from the hour of 8 A.M. to 8 P.M. of said day; that the Chief of Police is instructed to place polling boothes, pens, pencils, and ballots for the purpose of providing for said election and the Recorder is

directed to provide poll books therefore.

Section 7. In as much as there is a demand by some of the people of the City of Lebanon for a municipal swimming pool, and the Council deems that it should be ascertained as soon as possible, whether a majority of the people favor the texation of property for the construction thereof, this ordinance is for the peace, health, and safety, and general welfare of the people of the City of Lebanon, and an emergency is therefore declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force from and after its passage by the council and approval by the Mayor.
