ORDINANCE BEEL NO. 648

AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING ONE-WAY TRAFFIC AND PROHIBITING PARKING IN CERTAIN AREAS.

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 567 passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor on November 17, 1942, is hereby amended as follows:

(a) There shall be added to said Ordinance a Section to be known as Section 3a, which shall provide as follows:

"3a. From the date of the opening of the extension of Park Street South from Oak Street to the intersection of Main and Elmore Streets, all vehicular traffic on Park Street between the latter point and the intersection of Park and Carolina Streets shall proceed North; that from said date all vehicular traffic on Carolina Street between Park and Main Streets shall proceed West; and from said date all vehicular traffic on Main Street from Carolina Street to Elmore Street shall proceed South; said Streets being hereby designated as "one-way" Streets for the exclusive use of traffic in one direction only".

- (b) There shall be added to Section 19 of said Ordinance a subsection (g), which will provide as follows:
 - "(g). From the date of the opening of the extension of Park Street South from Oak Street to the intersection of Main and Elmore Streets, it shall be unlawful to park any vehicle on the West side of Park Street from the intersection of Ash and Park Streets North to the intersection of Park and Carolina Streets or on the South side of Carolina Street between Park and Main Streets".
