

ORDINANCE BILL NO. 3 for 1948.

ORDINANCE NO. 653

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE STREET WIDTH, CURB,
AND SIDEWALK LINES ON SOUTH MAIN STREET.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, OREGON,
DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

That the width of South Main Street, from Elmore Street South to the City Limits shall be increased to eighty (80) feet; the sidewalk line shall be one (1) foot out into the street from the property line, and the curb line shall be eight (8) feet from the property line on each side of said street; and the width of regulation sidewalks thereon shall be five (5) feet.
