ORDINANCE NO. 656

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 647.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section 3 of Ordinance No. 647 shall be amended to read as follows:

Section 3. That applications for licenses to operate such a business, pursuit or occupation, and for an increase in the number of vehicles to be used therein, shall be made in writing to the City Council of said city, and each application shall contain a statement, under oath, of the applicant as to his or its financial status and responsibility, the description of the equipment to be used and the type of service the applicant shall render. The Council shall have the right to demand further information and particulars concerning the applicant and the service he proposes to render, and shall be the sole and final judge of whether the applicant is properly qualified to enter such business and render such service within the city of Lebanon, and thereafter to continue in the same, if there arises a question as to whether said license should be revoked for good cause, or should be renewed, and as to whether there is a

public necessity and convenience to justify
the granting of said application and the
issuance of said license, and there shall be
no appeal from the rejection of any such
application or revocation of any such license
by a majority vote of the Council.
