ORDINANCE No. 657

AN ORDINANCE LIMITING STORAGE OF LIQUID PETROLEUM GAS.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS
FOLLOWS:

- 1. It shall be unlawful to store or possess more than six (6) gallons of liquid petroleum gas within the fire limits of the City of Lebanon, and any lesser amount shall be stored and used only in the manner approved by the requirements and specifications on the Oregon State Bureau of Labor.
- 2. It shall be unlawful to store or possess any larger quantity of liquid petroleum gas than 150 gallons in any place within the city limits of the City of Lebanon outside the fire limits, and in any case, such storage and possession shall be only in containers and under conditions prescribed by the rules and regulations of the Oregon Bureau of Labor.
- 3. Any person violating either of the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof in the Recorder's Court be punished by a fine of not to exceed. \$100.00 for the first violation, and not to exceed \$ for any subsequent violation thereof.
