

In the Matter of a Drainage District for the Drainage of the following described Area of the City of Lebanon to wit:

Beginning at the intersection of the center line of Park Street with the North line of Grant Street, and running thence East along the North line of Grant Street to the Lebanon and Santiam Canal; thence following along the West bank of said canal to the Southeast corner of Block 5, Park Addition; thence North along the East line of said Park addition to the South line of Kirkpatrick's Third Addition; thence East along the South line of Kirkpatrick's Third Addition to the Southeast corner of Block 5 of said addition; thence North along East line of said block 5 to the South line of Isabella Street, thence East along the South line of Isabella Street to the East line of Santiam Street; thence North along the East line of Santiam Street to the City Limits; thence in a Northwesterly direction along said city limit line, to the North line of Block 4, Kirkpatrick's Third Addition; thence West to the center line of Park Street; thence South along the center line of Park Street to the place of beginning

ORDINANCE BILL NO. 19.

ORDINANCE NO. 669.

WHEREAS, By resolution No. 12 for 1948, passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor on the 18th day of May, 1948, the Council declared the above described area to be a drainage district and,

WHEREAS, The City Engineer has made and filed plans, specifications and estimates for the drainage of said area which were approved and adopted by said resolution and,

WHEREAS, The City Recorder has caused notice of the

intention of the City to make said improvements, and the time for publication thereof, as prescribed by the Charter has elapsed and no remonstrances thereto have been made or filed herein,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

I.

That the Council does hereby take jurisdiction of said proposed improvement and orders that the same shall be done by contract to be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder with the right of the City to reject any, and all bids;

II.

That the Recorder is hereby ordered to publish for ten (10) days in a newspaper published in Lebanon, Oregon, a notice inviting proposals for the construction of said drains referring to the plans and specifications and estimates therefore filed in his office.

III.

That said work shall commence not later than 1948, and shall be completed not later than 1948;

IV.

That said work shall be done in the manner provided by the plans and specifications heretofore filed by the City Engineer and approved by the Council; and the contractor shall be subject to the penalties for default or failure to complete said work in the manner and within the time provided in his contract with the City, and shall indemnify the City by a bond in an appropriate amount with a surety or sureties approved by the Council for the faithful and prompt performance of said contract, and for the payment of damages for the failure thereof in the sum or sums provided in said contract.
