ORDINANCE NO. ~~627~~ 671

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 520 TO REGULATE STORAGE OF FLAMMABLE LIQUIDS.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section 1 of Ordinance No. 520

shall be amended to read and provide as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, corporation, or firm to erect or install, or to cause to be erected or installed, or to have, maintain, or operate within the City of Lebanon, hereafter, any tank, container, vessel or other receptacle the capacity of which shall exceed five thousand (5000) gallons, for the purpose of containing or storing any flammable liquids with a flash point of under one hundred degrees (100°); and any such container or tank of a capacity of less than five thousand gallon (5000) capacity and greater than permitted by Ordinance Number 248 as amended by Ordinance 362, shall comply with the following specifications, to-wit:

1. Such tank shall be buried underground and if with a capacity of not to exceed two thousand (2000) gallon, the top of the tank shall be lower than all floors, basements, cellars or pits of all buildings within a radius of ten feet (10); and if in excess of two thousand (2000) gallon capacity but not exceeding five thousand (5000) gallons the top of said tank shall be lower than all floors, basements, cellars or pits of all buildings within a radius of twenty (20) feet; provided that where adjoining property is not built upon, the capacity of the underground tank shall be limited with respect to the adjoining property as if a seven (7) foot basement existed.

2. All tanks shall bear the label of Underwriters' Laboratories, Inc. or other nationally recognized laboratories and be approved by the Fire Chief.

3. All tanks shall have such valves, vents and connections as shall be approved by the National Board of Fire Underwriters' Regulations.

The regulations herein provided shall apply only to storage tanks to be maintained for retail sales of flammable liquids and shall not be construed to permit the maintenance of such tanks for full sales as otherwise prohibited by ordinance.

This Ordinance shall not apply to any motor vehicle or trailers duly registered or licensed nor to their motors while on such motor vehicles or trailers.
