

ORDINANCE BILL NO. 28 PRO 1948

ORDINANCE NO. 678

An ordinance to amend Section 8 of Ordinance No. 585, to increase the schedule of license fees.

Section 1. That Section 8 of Ordinance No. 585 passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor, February 5, 1943, be amended to read and provide as follows:

Section 8. Each applicant for license required by this ordinance shall pay a fee for the license according to the following fee schedule:
