

ORDINANCE BILL NO. 3 FOR 1949

ORDINANCE NO. 688

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING AND DEDICATING PROPERTY TO THE PUBLIC FOR THE USE AS A STREET, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

That the following described property to-wit:

A parcel of land lying in the Southeast quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section 10, and the Southwest quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section 11, Township 12 South, Range 2 West, W. M., Linn County, Oregon, and being a portion of the following described property: That tract of land which was conveyed by that certain deed to Robert C. Sipe and Blanche H. Sipe recorded in Book 172, Page 881 of Linn County Record of Deeds. The said parcel being all that portion of the foregoing described property included in a strip of land 60 feet in width, 30 feet on each side of the center line of the Santiam Highway as said highway has been relocated over and across or adjacent to the said property; the location of the said strip of land (in so far as it encroaches upon said property) being determined by the said center line from Station 781/53.9 to Station 785/06.5 which portion of center line is described as follows:


Beginning at a point which is Engineer's center line Station 781/53.9 opposite and 30 feet distant from which point the Easterly line of the said strip of land intersects the North line of said property; said point being 1665 feet North and 1533.4 feet West of the Southeast corner of the Wm. Ralston D. L. C. #48 in Township 12 South, Range 2 West W. M.; thence 82.02 feet on a spiral curve right (the long chord of which bears South 44° 01' West, 82.61 feet) thence South 45° 09' West, 141.15 feet; thence 128.83 feet on a spiral curve left (the long chord of which bears South 44° 44' 30" West, 128.80 feet) to Station 785/06.5 opposite and 25.52 Northwesterly from which Station the West line of said property intersects the North line of Elmore Street, containing 0.39 acre.

be and the same is hereby appropriated and dedicated to the public for public use as a street, and shall hereafter be subject to all of the rules, regulations, and ordinances of the City of Lebanon relating to streets, and the name of said street shall be Park Street.



That it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the City of Lebanon that this Ordinance take effect immediately, and, therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
