In the Matter of a Drainage District for the Drainage of the following described area of the City of Lebanon to-wit:

Beginning at the intersection of the center line of Hiatt Street and the center line of the Southern Pacific Railroad Tract, thence South along center line of Hiatt Street to the intersection of the center line of Hiatt Street and the center line of Elmore Street, thence East along the center line of Elmore Street to the intersection of the center line of Elmore Street and the center line of Franklin Street, the ce South along the center line of Franklin Street to the South City Limit Line, thence Westerly along the South City Limit Line to the intersection of the South City Limit line and the right bank of the Lebanon and Santiam Canal, thence North and Northeasterly along said bank of said Canal to the center line of the Southern Pacific Railroad, thence East along the center line of said railroad to the point of beginning.

ORDINANCE NO. 70%

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE TAKING JURISDICTION OF THE PROPOSED DRAINAGE DISTRICT ABOVE DESCRIBED, KNOWN AS DRAINAGE DISTRICT NUMBER FOUR, AND ORDERING RECORDER TO PUBLISH NOTICE INVITING PROPOSALS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF DRAINS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY:

WHEREAS, ^By Resolution No. 5 for 1949, passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor on the 4th day of April, 1949, the Council declared the above described area to be a drainage district and,

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has made and filed plans, specifications and estimates for the drainage of said area which were approved and adopted by said resolution and,

WHEREAS, The Gity Recorder has caused notice of the intention of the City to make said improvements, and the time for publication thereof, as presecribed by the Charter has elapsed and no remonstrances thereto have been made or filed herein, NOW, THEREFORE, THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

I.

That the Council does hereby take jurisdiction of said proposed improvement and orders that the same shall be done by contract to be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder with the right of the City to reject any, and all bids;

II.

That the Recorder is hereby ordered to publish for ten (10) days in anewspaper published in Lebanon, Oregon, a notice inviting proposals for the construction of said drains referring to the plans and specifications and estimates therefore filed in her office.

III.

That said work shall commence not later than seven days after the contract has been awarded, and shall be completed prior to December 31, 1949.

IV.

That said work shall be done in the manner provided by the plans and specifications heretofore filed by the City Engineer and approved by the Council; and the contractor shall be subject to the penalties for default or failure to complete said work in the manner and within the time provided in his contract with the City, and shall indemnify the City by a bond in an appropriate amount with a surety or sureties approved by the Gouncil for the faithful and prompt performance of said contract, and for the payment of damages for the failure thereof in the sum or sums provided in said contract. It hereby is adjudged and declared that existing conditions are such that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the people of the city of Lebanon; and an emergency hereby is declared o exist, and this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
