ORDINANCE BILL NO. 49 FOR 1949 ORDINANCE NO. 729

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 703, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY:

THE PROPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBRION DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

That Ordinance No. 703 be amended to read as follows:

Section I. Except as other wise provided by Ordinance, on streets 60 feet or more in width all curbs shall be 14 feet from the property line, on streets 50 feet in width all curbs shall be 10 feet from the property line, and on streets 40 feet in width all curbs shall be 6 feet from the property line.

Section II. All curbs on Main Street South of B Street and on Maple Street from Park Street to Second Street shall be 10 feet from the Property line.

Section III. All curbs on Sherman Street from Park Street to the first alley West of Main Street and on Ash Street from Second Street to the first alley East of Main Street shall be 8 feet from the property line.

Section IV. All curbs lines on Park Street from Dodge Street to wheeler Street shall be 10 feet from the property line.

Section V. The curb line on the South side of Wheeler Street beginning with the intersection of Wheeler Street and williams Street and running thence East on wheeler Street 519.54 feet and the curb lines on the East and West sides of williams Street beginning with the Worth line of Dodge Street and running North to Wheeler Street shall be 11 feet from the property line.

Section VI. All of the curb lines on Cleveland Street from Grant Street to Cak Street shall be 12 leet from the property line.

Section VII. That the improvment of Cleveland Street from Grant street to tak Street will be commenced soon and it is important that the curb lines on that street be set back to conform to such improvment, and this ordinance therefore being required for the peace, health and safety of the said ty, an emergency is hereby declared and said Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Payor.

Passed by the Council and approved by the Payor this 21st day of June, 1949.
