

ORDINANCE BILL NO. 51 FOR 1949

ORDINANCE NO. 731

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE REGULATING PARKING ON MAIN STREET IN THE CITY OF LEBANON FROM A POINT 20 FEET SOUTH OF THE SOUTH LINE OF CAROLINA STREET PROJECTED TO THE CROWN ZELLERBACK RAILWAY TRACK, PROVIDING FOR A NO PASSING STRIPE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY:

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

- (1). No person, firm or corporation shall park or cause to be parked any motor vehicle at any time on the West side of Main Street from a point thereon which is 20 feet South of the South line of Carolina Street projected to the North line of Wheeler Street projected.
- (2) There shall hereafter be maintained adjacent to and on both sides of the center line of Main Street from a point thereon which is 20 feet South of the South line of Carolina Street projected, North to the North line of Wheeler Street, projected, a painted "no passing stripe", and it shall be unlawful for the operator of any motor vehicle to pass any other motor vehicle proceeding in the same direction along any part of said stripe.
- (3) Motor Vehicles shall be parked parallel to the curb and not otherwise on both sides of Main Street, the same being U. S. Highway No. 20, from Wheeler Street projected North to the Crown Zellerback Corporation Railway Track.
- (4) Any person, firm or corporation convicted of violating this ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$100.00 or by imprisonment in the City jail of not more than 10 days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.
- (5) It is hereby declared that existing conditions are such that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
