

In the Matter of a Drainage District
for the Drainage of the following
described area of the City of
Lebanon to-wit:

Beginning at the Intersection of
the center line of Olive Street and
4th Street, thence South along the
center line of 4th Street to the
center line of S. P. Railroad track
thence Southeasterly direction along
the center line of S. P. Railroad
track to a point 162 feet North of
the center line of Rose Street, thence
East along the North side of Lot 7,
and Lot 3, Block 17 Ralston's Third
Addition and the North line of Lot 7,
Block 16, Ralston's Second Addition
to the center line of the alley in
Block 16, thence North along the

center line of said alley projected
to a point due West of the center
line of Carolina Street projected,
thence East along said center line
projected to the center line of Main
Street, thence North along the center
line of Main Street to a point 250
feet North of intersection of the
center line of Main Street and
Wheeler Street, thence West on a
line parallel to the center line of
Morton Street projected to the
center line of Main Street, thence
North along the center line of
Main Street to the center line of
Olive Street, thence West along said
center line to the place of beginning.)

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE TAKING JURISDICTION OF THE PROPOSED DRAINAGE
DISTRICT ABOVE DESCRIBED; KNOWN AS DRAINAGE DISTRICT NUMBER SIX,
AND ORDERING RECORDER TO PUBLISH NOTICE INVITING PROPOSALS FOR THE
CONSTRUCTION OF DRAINS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY:

WHEREAS, By Resolution No. 24 for 1949, passed by the Council
and approved
and approved by the Mayor on the 7th day of June, 1949, the Council
declared the above described area to be a drainage district and,

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has made and filed plans,
specifications and estimates for the drainage of said area which
were approved and adopted by said resolution and,

WHEREAS, The City Recorder has caused notice of intention
of the City to make said improvements, and the time for publication
thereof, as prescribed by the Charter has elapsed and no remonstrance
thereto have been made or filed herein,

ORDINANCE BILL NO. 52

ORDINANCE NO. 732

NOW, THEREFORE, THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO
ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

I.

That the Council does hereby take jurisdiction of said proposed improvement and orders that the same shall be done by contract to be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder with the right of the City to reject any, and all bids;

II.

That the Recorder is hereby ordered to publish for ten (10) days in a newspaper published in Lebanon, Oregon, a notice inviting proposals for the construction of said drains referring to the plans and specifications and estimates therefore filed in her office.

III.

That said work shall commence not later than seven days after the contract has been awarded, and shall be completed prior to December 31, 1949.

IV.

That said work shall be done in the manner provided by the plans and specifications heretofore filed by the City Engineer and approved by the Council; and the Contractor shall be subject to the penalties for default or failure to complete said work in the manner and within the time provided in his contract with the City, and shall indemnify the City by a bond in an appropriate amount with a surety or sureties approved by the Council for the faithful and prompt performance of said contract, and for the payment of damages for the failure thereof in the sum or sums provided in said contract.

V.

It is hereby adjudged and declared that existing conditions are such that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon; and an emergency hereby is declared to

exist, and this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
