## ORDINANCE BILL NO. 62 FOR 1949

ORDINANCE NO. 742

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE # 429 AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE # 625.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section I. That Section II of Ordinance # 429 as amended by Ordinance #625 shall be amended to read as follows:

Section 2. The fire department shall consist of four companies numbered consecutively beginning with number one; and each company shall consist of not more than ten firemen, who shall be members of the Lebanon "ire Department; provided, that the personnel of the fire department shall be limited to thirty- hfly five members. Each company shall have one captain and one lieutenant to be appointed by the Chief of the fire department, subject to confirmation by the Council, At the time of the appointment of captains and lieutenants, the Chief shall also appoint, subject to confirmation by the ouncil, an assistant chief, secretary and treasurer. The offices of Secretary and Treasurer may be combined in one person. The organization, conduct and activities of the fire department shall be subject to such rules and regulations as may be prescribed by the fire department as a whole with the approval of the City Council provided however a whole with the approval of the City Council, provided, however, that the Council may from time to time by Resolution authorize additional companies to Be formed with a like number of members as herein provided for companies one, two, three and four. The appointment of Captains, Lieutenants Assistant Chief, secretary and treasurer shall be made prior to the regular monthly meeting of the fire department in April of each year. The term of office of the captains, lieutenants, assistant chief, secretary and treasurer shall be for one year beginning with the regular monthly meeting of the fire department in April of each year. If at any time there occurs a vacancy in any of the offices above numerated the Chief shall immediately after such vacancy make an appointment to fill the same, subject, however, to confirmation by the Council.

Section II. That Section IV of Ordinance # 429 be amended

to read as follows:

Section 4. At its last regular meeting in December of each year beginning with the calendar year 1949, the Council shall appoint the fire chief of the fire department to be effective as of the first day of January of the following year. If at any time there occurs a vacancy in the office of Chief the Council shall immediately thereafter make an appointment to fill such vacancy. The fire chief shall hold office for one year. Wherever in this ordinance there appears the term Chief Engineer and the term Fire Chief they shall be c nstrued to be one and the same person and the term Assistant Chief Engineer and Assistant Fire Chief shall be construed to be one and the same person.
