ORDINANCE NO. 765 A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 588 The People of the City of Lebanon Do Ordain as Follows: That Ordinance No. 588 be amended to read as follows: Section 1. All public places, except restaurants and confectionaries where billairds, pool or combinations of billiards and pool are played or where shuffle bowler, high-rol or any other sport, game recreation or amusement is played or conducted regularly for hire, or profit, or where tables for such play are kept or used for hire or profit, and all skating rinks and bowling alleys shall be closed from 12 o'clock midnight until 5 o'clock the following m morning during every day in each week. Provided that in restaurants and confectionaries no games shall be played between 12 o'clock midnight and the following morning of any day in the week. In addition to this regulation there shall be the further regulation that none of said games or amusements shall be played in any public place between the hours of 5 o'clock Sunday Morning and 1 o'clock Sunday Afternoon. Section II. No person shall conduct or operate within the City of Lebenon any shooting gallery without first securing from the City Council a license therefore, and such license shall contain such conditions or restrictions as the City Council deems to be for the best interest of the City. The City Council shall have the power to refuse the issuance of such a license if they feel that the issuance of such would be detrimental to the peace, health and safety of the residents of the City. No license shall be issued which would permit the operation of a shooting gallery between the hours of 12 o'clock paturday night and 5 o'clock Monday morning.

Section III. Any person, firm or corporation violating this ordinance shall be punished by a fine not more than \$100.00 or by imprisonment in the City jail not more than 50 days.

Section IV. All ordinances or portions of ordinances which are in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

It hereby is adjudged and declared that existing conditions are such that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety; and an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
