ORDINANCE NO. 766

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING PARAGRAPH NO. 5 ,
SECTION 2, ORDINANCE NO. 586 BY SPECIFYING THE WIDTH OF THE
SIDEWALK ON THE WEST SIDE OF WILLIAMS STREET FROM MILTON
STREET TO ELMORE STREET.

The People of the City of Lebanon do Ordain as follows:

That Paragraph No. 5, Section 2 of Ordinance No. 586 shall
be amended as follows:

"For Sidewalks: Cement Sidewalks shall be 5 feet wide,
except along the following portions of the following streets,
when they shall be of the widths indicated:

Main Street from Maple Street to Ash Street: 8 feet wide
Main Street from Ash Street to Vine Street: 6 feet wide
Side Streets, running East and West, adjacent
to Main Street, from Maple Street to Ash Street: 6 feet wide
Sherman Street from Main Street to Third Street: 8 feet wide
Grant Street from Main Street to Third Street: 8 feet wide
The West side of Williams Street from Milton
Street to Elmore Street: 4½ feet wide"
