ORDINANCE BILL NO. 55 FOR 1950

THE PEOPLE OF THE CTTY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section I. That the monthly salaries of certain City officials shall be the amounts set after their names as follows, to be effective as of October 1, 1950.

Section II. In as much as increased living costs have resulted in a hardship on the above listed officers and employees it is acertained that this Ordinance become effective immediately in order to pay the salaries as increased by this ordinance, and that this ordinance is necessary for the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
