ORDINANCE NO. 824

AN ORDINANCE SETTING THE SALARIES OF CERTAIN OFFICERS OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

The people of the city of Lebanon do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the monthly salaries of the following city officers for the fiscal year beginning with July 1, 1951 and ending on June 30, 1952 shall be the amounts set after their names as follows:

City Recorder-Treasurer	\$333.33
Assistant to City Recorder	250.00
Chief of Police	333.33
Other Police Officers	,300.00
Paid Firemen	300.00
Street Superintendent	333.33
Other Street Employees	300.00
City Attorney	125.00
Assistant Chief of Police	308.33

Section 2. Inasmuch as no official action has heretofore been taken setting the salaries of the officers hereinabove named, in accordance with provisions made in the city budget heretofore adopted, and this ordinance being necessary for the peace, health, and safety of the people of the city of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage by the council and approval by the mayor.
